Mayor Rawlings-Blake Implements CEAS in Baltimore

BALTIMORE, MD. (February 10, 2010) – With the city operating under Phase III of the Snow Emergency Plan, Mayor Stephanie Rawlings-Blake activated the Corporate Emergency Access System (CEAS.) CEAS is an emergency access control system that allows critical business employees to enter and travel in restricted areas during serious emergencies. Baltimore activated CEAS in November of 2009.
