**CAMBRIDGE CEAS PROGRAM NOW OFFERS EMERGENCY ACCESS TANDEM CARDS
FOR BUSINESSES WITH MULTIPLE SITES**

The Business Network of Emergency Resources, Inc. (BNET) announced today the addition of Emergency Access Tandem Card availability for the Cambridge CEAS program. This program enhancement allows users to gain access to multiple works sites within Cambridge through the use of a secondary or “Tandem Card”, which can list up to six addition locations. BNet is a not-for-profit company dedicated to establishing practical, effective emergency, and crisis management solutions through public-private partnerships.

The CEAS program allows businesses and institutions to apply for and pre-issue emergency access credentials to critical business employees that are recognized by local law enforcement officials. The purpose of CEAS is to improve business resiliency by enabling these employees to gain quick access to their places of business within a restricted area following a local emergency or disaster.

The Tandem Card allows Cambridge’s CEAS users greater flexibility in assigning critical employees who might require access to more than one location without having to carry a separate card for each.

“We discovered very early in the enrollment process that many of Cambridge’s firms and institutions had more than one key facility within the City” said David O’Conner, Director of Emergency Management for the City of Cambridge. “The addition of Emergency Access Tandem Cards will greatly enhance flexibility for those organizations to get the right personnel into all of their key facilities if necessary.”

“The Emergency Access Tandem Card option was first introduced in New York City to meet wide demand for multi-facility access”, said Peter Picarillo, Executive Director of BNET. “We were glad to be able to meet the needs of Cambridge’s government and businesses in a timely fashion. Initially, we did not think there would be a need for Tandem Card access in Cambridge, but once we became aware of the necessity we were able to quickly provide a solution.”
